

**YUCCA FIRE DISTRICT
RESOLUTION # 11-2023-01
(Requesting Consolidation and Public Hearing)**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE YUCCA FIRE DISTRICT REQUESTING THAT A CONSOLIDATION WITH THE GOLDEN VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT BE CONSIDERED; DIRECTING THAT NOTICE OF SAID REQUEST BE COMMUNICATED TO THE GOLDEN VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT; AND DIRECTING THAT A PUBLIC HEARING BE HELD TO DETERMINE IF A CONSOLIDATION WOULD BE IN THE BEST INTEREST OF THE YUCCA FIRE DISTRICT AND THE GOLDEN VALLEY FIRE DISTRICT, AND WOULD PROMOTE THE PUBLIC SAFETY, HEALTH, COMFORT, CONVENIENCE, NECESSITY OR WELFARE.

WHEREAS, the Yucca Fire District was organized for purposes of providing fire and emergency medical services as more fully described in A.R.S. §48-805, etc.; and

WHEREAS, the Yucca Fire District is authorized pursuant to A.R.S. §48-822 to consider consolidation with other fire districts; and

WHEREAS, the Yucca Fire District is committed to ensuring that the residents and property owners of the District continue to receive quality, cost effective fire district services for the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, the Governing Board of the Yucca Fire District believes that residents and property owners of the District might be better served by consolidating with the Golden Valley Fire District; and that a consolidated District would be in the best interest of the District and would promote the public safety, health, comfort, convenience, necessity or welfare; and


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that, pursuant to A.R.S. §48-822 a consolidation of the Yucca Fire District with the Golden Valley Fire District be considered;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that this request for possible consolidation be forwarded by first class mail to the Golden Valley Fire District for consideration;

FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon approval by the Golden Valley Fire District, a public hearing be held to determine if a consolidation would be in the best interest of the District and would promote the public safety, health, comfort, convenience, necessity or welfare, and in conjunction therewith that a feasibility study be completed to assist in making that determination.
